Bidders MUST purchase bidding documents and be registered with the engineer as a plan holder in order to submit a bid for consideration.

A Prebid conference is tentatively scheduled for 2:00 p.m., Monday May 5, 2008 at New Haven City Hall. All interested bidders and subcontractors are encouraged to attend. Sealed bids must be submitted for the project on the Bid Form included with the Bidding Documents. Bid envelopes must state "***New Haven Wastewater Collection System Improvements Project***". Failure to state this on the bid envelope may result in the bid being returned without it being considered. Each Bidder must file with their bid a Bid Security in the amount of five percent (5%) of their total bid.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive informalities or irregularities, and to determine the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder, and to award the contract on that basis.

The prevailing hourly rate of wages, as determined by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, will be complied with on this project, and not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages as found by the agencies or Court of Appeals shall be paid to all workmen performing work under this contract.
